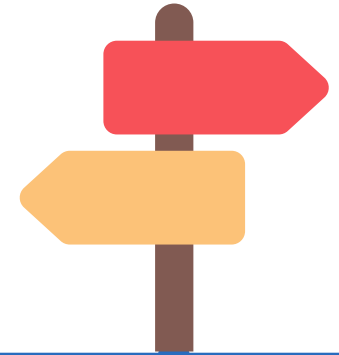

OUTCOME

Tangata Whai Ora are keen and interested in studying the Certificate in Health & Wellbeing - Peer Support.

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- Tangata Whai Ora may contact or email Kites for more information on Scholarship.
- Kites may direct Tangata Whai ora on the Certificate programme over on Whiteria website and contact person.

Tangata Whai Ora first officially enrolls for the Level 4 Certificate, excited about the opportunity for learning and growth.

- Applies formally to Kites to be considered for the scholarship via form with:
- A cover letter explaining their suitability for the scholarship.
- Two professional references.
- Evidence of employment or volunteering in a Peer Support role.
- Evidence that their employment organisation will support them on this education journey.

Eligibility for Peer Support Certificate Scholarships

- Your own lived experience of mental health distress and addiction.
- Enrolled in the Certificate in Health & Wellbeing - Peer Support.
- A paid position or volunteer work in peer support.
- Priority given to students who meet all course criteria and are Māori, Pacific, or Youth Peer Support workers (29 years or younger).

- Kites Trust will contact shortlisted applicants for an in-person interview to understand their motivations and suitability for the scholarship.
- The scholarship is awarded on a rolling basis aligned with the enrolment of the certificate programme.
- Awardees are expected to graduate with this certificate and proactively build a plan with Whireia and their employer to enable educational success

- Kites Trust will inform applicants of their scholarship outcome.
- Kites will coordinate with Whireia for processing successful scholarships.
- Announce successful awardees on Kites website and celebrate at graduation.
- Kites will provide a check-in call with awardees and their organisations within two months to discuss study progress.
- If applicant hasn't enrolled, then their scholarship is conditional on successfully enrolling into the programme
- Unsuccessful scholarship applicants who wish to unenroll must contact Whireia.
